A few days ago, some of you received a call regarding the news that we have several residents/employees who have tested positive for Covid 19. We all knew that it was inevitable, in spite of our best efforts. We are fortunate to have a great team, all working around the clock to take care of our residents.

Many of the families have asked about the vaccination clinic, which is in place for January 19th. In speaking with Ruth, she informed me that we're planning on proceeding with the clinic, barring any unforeseen circumstances. It will be assessed on a case-case basis, based on uniform clinical data criteria established by the RIDOH/CDC. Also, currently our residents and staff are being swabbed minimally every three days, and more frequently if needed, based on RIDOH guidelines.

I am available to all of you on a 24-hour basis. As Ruth always ends, wash your hands, socially distance, wear a mask, and stay within your small circle of friends/family.
